CSR Vision (cont'd)


- Foster friendly relations with the community, create community arts spaces and protect the environment

AAEON and Suppliers

- Suppliers must comply with the EU RoHS directives
- Encourage all suppliers to comply with the "Electronic Industry Code of Conduct", a set of norms involving labor and recruitment, health and safety, environmental responsibility, management systems and ethics
- AAEON procurement select suppliers according to ISO-9001 QO2-017
 "Supplier Control Programs" for higher quality and environmental protection
- AAEON procurement TL-9000 QD4-089 ensures supplier pledge of non-toxic (TF=Toxin-free) products to comply with EU RoHS and REACH regulations

Green Commitment

- Uphold 3R (Reuse, Recycle, Reduce) principles, to reduce pollution
- Green Product Design emphasizes the use of green raw materials and WEEE (2002/96/EC Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment) processing considerations during design and manufacturing, and energy saving designs (e.g. fanless designs)
- Environmentally friendly packaging design, and use or renewable materials
- Committed to ISO-9001, ISO-14001, ISO-13485 ANSI/ESD S20.20 certifications
- EU RoHS (2011/65/EU Hazardous Substances Directive) compliance
